

Finding items in the Government Documents microfiche/microcard collections

The *Monthly Catalog of United States Publications* contains entries for items published by the Government Printing Office (GPO).

The *Readex Government Documents* microprint collection contains the full text (on microfilm or microcard) of many of the items listed in the *Monthly Catalog*.

There are two sets of documents – depository and non-depository.

The **non-depository** collection began in 1953.

The **depository** collection began in 1956.

In some cases, we may also have a particular item available in paper. When we don't, the Government Documents collection is the next place to check.

To locate items in the microprint collection, you must identify the monthly catalog entry number *and* determine whether the item is “depository” or “non-depository”.

From 1994 -, the *Monthly Catalog* (renamed the *Catalog of U.S. Government Publications*) is available online through GPOAccess <http://www.gpoaccess.gov/cgp/index.html>.

The **Catalog entry number** is in the **990a** field of the record.

Prior to 1994, you must check the print version of the *Monthly Catalog*, shelved in the Reference Stacks Z 1223 A18. The **entry number** is in the upper-left hand corner of the entry. A black dot in the entry indicates a *depository* item. If there is no black dot, it is a *non-depository* item.

Through 1980, the Government Documents collection is available on **microcard**. The microcard boxes are shelved in a section labeled Government Documents in the Lower Level Vault. There is one set of boxes for the non-depository items and another set for the depository. Entries are filed by the **Monthly Catalog entry number**.

From 1981 -, the Government Documents collection is available on microfiche in the media center. The cabinets are labeled "Government Documents" Depository and Non-depository collection. Fiche are organized by year. Within each year, there is a section for Depository items followed by a section of non-depository items. Entries are filed by the **Monthly Catalog entry number** in the appropriate section.
